Course Overview

We will focus on the 3 main text types of writing and learn how to write in MLA (Modern Language Association) format. Students will write 3-4 essays throughout the school year. Most of this will take place in class so I can conference with the students about their progress. Additionally, we will explore a variety of video clips, fiction and non-fiction texts while focusing on critical thinking to help improve listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Students will participate in a variety of assignments via Google Classroom, i-Ready, Achieve 3000, Scope Scholastic, and class handouts. Some of the video clips we watch may contain inappropriate language, racial slurs, or crude scenes and may evoke emotions throughout the learning. Google Classroom

- Google Classroom is how students connect to my digital classroom to see assignments and messages I have posted. It is a great platform because it gives students access to almost everything they need, whether they are at school or home.
- It is where I communicate with each class regularly and <u>it will have the majority of the English</u> assignments.
- Students will be responsible for checking Google Classroom <u>daily</u>.
- Google Classroom is provided for each student on their iPad.
- Google Classroom is for students only, however, parents can view the app on their child's iPad at any time. Additionally, parents can monitor their child's progress by registering for daily or weekly updates.

<u>Academic Integrity</u> - Honest behavior and integrity are expectations for all students. I am committed to creating an ethical academic atmosphere. Students will obtain an F grade for any essay/assignment that is plagiarized or copied. Consequently, they will also receive a behavioral referral to administration. Specific types of academic dishonesty, which will result in disciplinary action, are defined below:

- Cheating any intentional giving or use of external assistance relating to an essay, assignment, examination, test, or quiz without the explicit permission of the teacher
- Plagiarism the practice of taking someone else's words, work, or ideas and passing them off as one's own.
- Unauthorized collaboration while collaboration is often encouraged, unauthorized collaboration is not permitted.

Due Dates and Late Work Policy

I grade late work as fast as I can. Please remember I have 120 students, so sometimes this could take a few weeks to get updated.

- If a student is absent on the day that an ESSAY is due, they will only receive half credit.
- It is the student's responsibility to obtain work they missed and turn it in. Students should check Google Classroom and the green basket in class for handouts. When in doubt, ALWAYS ASK ME.
- When absent, students need to contact me about extended time. Late work will only be accepted late up to 2 weeks after the due date.
- Students will receive a **ZERO GRADE** in PowerSchool **until the late work is turned in and graded**.
- Once late work is graded, PowerSchool will be updated and the ZERO GRADE will be removed.
- There are always exceptions due to extreme illness.

All work is graded based on the mastery level demonstrated. Grades are posted on PowerSchool. All work is weighted equally.
